Job Purpose:

Responsible for the overall on-site operations at the school test site, including day to day workforce management.

Key Responsibilities:

- To run the day to day operations including on-site workforce management
- To manage test site health and safety
- To receive and manage stock
- To set up other team members on the NHS Test and Trace digital service
- To be the point of escalation for any issues on site, and to further escalate to local public health officials as appropriate
- To ensure adherence to defined testing processes throughout operations
- To ensure use of correct tests on test site
- To be responsible for the safety and security of the site
- To deal with any data privacy concerns by directing subjects to the Data Privacy notice which explains how data will be used
- To implement appropriate quality assurance as defined by the programme
- To implement the incident and risk reporting system that is used within the mass testing programme
- To undertake testing staff competency and performance reviews
- To retain a weekly summary of your records and any lessons learned to report to DfE/DHSC
