



Class Teacher - Job Description

Main Purpose

The post-holder will be expected to manage all aspects of teaching and learning as set out in the Teachers Standards document. The post-holder will be responsible for ensuring high quality teaching and learning takes place in their class.

The successful candidate will be required to exercise their professional skills and judgment to carry out the professional duties set out below in a collaborative manner.

Responsibilities

- Encourage pupils' motivation and enthusiasm, securing positive attitudes to learning and high standards of behaviour.
- Monitor, evaluate and review pupils' progress, achievement and attainment and ensure appropriate action plans are in place where issues are identified.
- Monitor, evaluate and review the quality of learning and teaching in accordance with school policy.
- Support curriculum leaders in the development and implementation of curricular and cross curricular initiatives.
- Support the pastoral care of pupils.
- Work collaboratively with all members of staff, and promote a multi-agency approach to working with external agencies
- Ensure all teaching is inclusive of all children.
- Have a detailed professional knowledge and understanding of the knowledge progression of early childhood development.
- Develop and improve relevant subject knowledge and pedagogy.
- Ensure the promotion of methods that enable all pupils to learn effectively, including Home Learning.
- Identify own professional development needs and ensure that these needs are addressed through appropriate training.
- Disseminate examples of 'good practice' in learning and teaching, effective planning and provision.
- Actively support the aims and ethos of the school.
- Establish good relationships, encourage good working practices and support.

Child Protection

To be fully aware of and understand the duties and responsibilities arising from the Children's Act 2004 and Working Together in relation to child protection and safeguarding children and young people as this applies to the post holder's role within the school

To also be fully aware of the principles of safeguarding as they apply to children and young people in relation to the post holder's role.

To ensure that the post holder's line manager is made aware and kept fully informed of any concerns which the post holder may have in relation to safeguarding and/or child protection
