Thank you for your interest in the post of Assistant Headteacher at Hatton School.

I joined the school in September 2023 and feel privileged to be working with such an amazing group of pupils and a friendly, committed and talented staff team. I received a warm welcome from staff and families and have been supported to get to know the wider school community.

We have 192 pupils on roll, most with a diagnosis of autism. They are grouped in 26 classes, two of which are co-located in mainstream schools, providing these pupils with inclusion opportunities. We have approximately 170 staff in our school. It is a large but friendly community, you will receive a warm welcome and quickly feel part of the Hatton family.

As Assistant hHadteacher of our school you will be responsible for the oversight of pastoral care and overall curriculum provision for approximately half of the class groups in the school. You will also line manage the teachers of these classes. You will work directly with one of our Deputy Headteachers and be supported in your role by a team leader. Both Assistant Headteachers have a significantly reduced teaching commitment to give you time to achieve this but it is expected you will be accessible and present in classes and around the school. We believe leadership is most effective when it is collaborative and leaders are fully informed about how they can enable and empower others to be successful.

You will also work with the senior team, using your experience and insight to help set the strategic direction to drive school development and innovation. We are a high performing school and are ambitious for our pupils. We want our practice to continue to develop and improve, you will be key to supporting staff on this journey.

The local authority has plans to expand our roll and including moving into additional premises, this is a development that has the potential to further improve our school offer.

We have recently reshaped and re-aligned our curriculum and assessment. As part of this we updated our curriculum purpose, mission and vision. We aim "to light the fire of curiosity and enquiry in the mind of every pupil. By empowering our staff to be ambitious and creative and take risks in learning. Leading to amazing lessons where we learn, grow and achieve; together". Hopefully that is a vision you can help us realise and the kind of school you would like to join.
